



## Ambassador Awards Program Guidelines

The GHRA Ambassador Award is an enrollment program designed to reward members for presenting their Gypsy Horse to the public.

### Enrollment requirements:

1. Horse must be registered with the Gypsy Horse Registry of America.
2. Each exhibitor of enrolled horse must hold a current membership with the Gypsy Horse Registry of America.
3. If a horse's registration is in process or pending, the event reporting form will be held until notification from the registrar of horse's completed registration. If registration is not completed by the end of the reporting period, all acquired points will be invalid.
4. The horse must be enrolled during the stated timeframe. Late entries will be accepted with limitations.

### Program guidelines:

1. Program is open to all GHRA registered horses and GHRA registered crossbreds.
2. The enrollment period begins every Jan 1<sup>st</sup> and closes Feb 28<sup>th</sup> (unless leap year).
3. Horses enrolled by the deadline will have all events counted beginning Jan 1<sup>st</sup>, horses enrolled after the deadline will only acquire points from the date of enrolled to the end of the reporting period, Dec 31<sup>st</sup>.
4. There are two award categories, Show and Exhibition each will be tabulated **separately** for year end awards.
5. The Show category includes all open and breed shows regardless of who is hosting the event. Only 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> placings will be counted in the final point tabulated. Please include any show that should be considered.
6. The Exhibition category includes but not limited to: Expos, Fairs, Parades, Sponsored Trail Rides, Clinics, etc. Please include any event that should be considered.
7. All submission will be verified, any falsified results will result in disqualification. Submission that are unverifiable will not be included in the final tabulation of points.
8. Open horses can be shown by any current GHRA member as the points will follow the horse. Amateur & Youth will be a horse/exhibitor combo.

### Year End Awards:

1. Points will be accumulated and tabulated to determine the award winners.
2. Awards will be given for the following:

Shows: High Point Youth & Reserve High Point Youth  
High Point Amateur & Reserve High Point Amateur  
High Point Open & Reserve High Point Open  
High Point Driving & Reserve High Point Driving  
High Point Dressage & Reserve High Point Dressage  
High Point Crossbred & Reserve High Point Crossbred

Exhibition: High Point Mare  
High Point Stallion  
High Point Gelding  
High Point Crossbred

### Point System:

1. Exhibitions will receive 100pts per attended event. For example, attending a state horse exposition which is from a fri-sun would be a total of 100pts if you attend all three days.
2. Shows:

1 <sup>st</sup> place = 200pts	Grand Champion = 200 pts
2 <sup>nd</sup> place = 150 pts	Reserve Grand Champion = 150 pts
3 <sup>rd</sup> place = 100 pts	Champion = 100 pts
4 <sup>th</sup> place = 75 pts	Reserve Champion = 50 pts
5 <sup>th</sup> place = 50 pts	
6 <sup>th</sup> place = 25 pts
